CBC's ACC Swimming Trifecta

CBC Fremantle won the Junior, Senior and Open Boys divisions at the Associated and Catholic Colleges (ACC) Swimming Carnival at Challenge Stadium on Wednesday.

The equation seemed pretty simple after the Carnival; effort equals reward.

After seven years in a row of winning the boys' aggregate total at the ACC 'A' Division carnival, it has never been more evident that the training our boys do makes the difference. Our training starts before any other schools in Term 4, continues during the Christmas holidays, and includes a time trial, a Quad meet and 12 Term 1 training sessions in preparation for the big day.

The morning started with a Blessing from Father Tony Maher, where he asked for God's help to bring out the best in our swimmers individually and collectively. The boys were challenged to swim for a personal best and to support each other in the quest for excellence.

The depth of our team again proved to be the difference. Of the six Division II relays we won one, had two seconds and two thirds. The Division I relays were just outstanding. Out of the six relays we won four, breaking three ACC records, came

second in one and third in the other. This is an amazing result and is testimony to the pride and determination our boys have in competing for CBC Fremantle.
